### Directions

Portsmouth Historic Dockyard is a pedestrian site open to the public between 9:00-17:30.

All public access is through 'Victory Gate' Sat Nav: PO1 3LJ.

#### By Train:

Portsmouth Harbour Station is just 2 minutes-walk from the Historic Dockyard.

#### By Car:

Portsmouth Historic Dockyard is less than 5 miles from Junction 12 of the M27, follow the brown and white signs to 'Historic Dockyard'. Since the Dockyard is a pedestrian-only site please plan to park outside.

For a single day visit you can use the Historic Dockyard's 295-space car park (charges apply) which is located only 400 yards from the entrance to Victory Gate (Sat Nav: PO1 3GW (Admiralty Road).

If this car park is full there are others within close proximity at Gunwharf Quays and Havant Street.
