


Please note

- There are three accessible toilets on site, one in the Pump House and two onboard the ship next to the Drill Hall and Galley.
- Light levels vary throughout the Pump House and ship.
- The ship is accessed via a ramp from the dockside. As the vessel is afloat, the gradient of the ramp changes due to the tidal nature of Belfast Lough. The ramp can be particularly steep at high tide.
- Please take care when moving around the ship as there are steep steps, uneven surfaces, low hanging ceilings and decks that may be slippery when wet. There are also three lifts on board HMS Caroline: one is located in the rear of the ship and two in the forward section of the ship.
- The Battle of Jutland film is loud, dark, includes flashing lights and contains images that may be upsetting to some visitors.
- There are loud soundscapes and interactives throughout the Museum.
- We have a limited number of sensory kits available to borrow at the ticketing desk, which include fidget toys, sensory cards, weighted lap blankets and ear defenders.
- A visual menu for the café is available on request.
- We have wheelchairs on site that may be borrowed free of charge.
- We run Sensory Explorer: Access Mornings throughout the year. Please check with a member of staff for the next event date.
- We have an Access Guide and Visual Guide available to download on our website. These can be used to help plan your visit.


