



Here is a pattern so that you can create your very own Little Butterfly at home.

LITTLE BUTTERFLY PATTERN— Pattern created by Jane Hobbs & Katrina Henderson from the Art Stop Café

This little Butterfly is made using two pieces knitted the same. Sew the two pieces together leaving a small gap for stuffing or you can not stuff it and have it flat. You may like to add patterns to your butterfly or leave it plain. To make your creation bigger or smaller you can alter the size of your needles and thickness of wool. Please make your Butterfly as individual as you like; why not add sequins, beads for the eyes and please make as many as you wish! Please do not make any of your butterflies larger than 15cm (6inches).

Difficulty rating: Intermediate

Needle Size: 4/5 mm

Wool: Double Knitting Yarn

Approx size: 7.5cm (3 inches)

WINGS -Make two identical

Cast on 4 stitches.

Row 1. Kfb, K2, Kfb (6)

Row 2. K6 (6)

Row 3. Kfb,K4,Kfb (8)

Row 4. K8 (8)

Row 5. Kfb,K6,Kfb (10)

Row 6. K10 (10)

Row 7. K2tog, K6, K2tog (8)

Row 8. K2tog,K4, K2tog (6)

Row 9. Kfb,K4,Kfb (8)

Row 10. Kfb, K6, Kfb (10)

Row 11. Kfb, K8, Kfb (12)

Row 12. K12 (12)

Row 13. Kfb, K10,Kfb (14)

Row 14. K14 (14)

Row 15. Kfb, K12, Kfb (16)

Row 16. K16 (16)

Row 17. K8 turn using those 8 stitches only continue (leaving other 8 stitches on the needle)

Row 18. K2tog, K4, K2tog (6)

Row 19. K2tog,K2, K2tog (4)

Row 20. K2tog,k2tog (2)

Row 21. K2 tog and pull yarn through.

Join yarn to remain 8 stitches and knit to end of row.

Finish to match other side (knit rows 18-21)

Knitting Key

K- Knit

P- Purl

Kfb- Knit in to front and back of stitch (increase)

K2tog- Knit two stitches together.

YON-Yarn Over Needle

TBL- Through back of loop

SS- Take Slip stitch over knitted stitch.

S- Slip Stitch

BODY— Make 1

Cast on 1 stitch

Row 1. Kfb (2)

Row 2. K1,YON,K1 (3)

Row 3. P1, P1TBL,P1 (3)

Row 4. K1 [YON K1] twice (5)

Row 5. P1 [P1 TBL,P1] twice (5)

Row 6. K5 (5)

Row 7. P5 (5)

Row 8. K5 (5)

Row 9. P5 (5)

Row 10. K2tog, K1,S1,K1,SS0 (3)

Row 11. P3 (3)

Row 12. K3 (3)

Row 13. P3 (3)

Row 14. K3 tog

Cast off and sew on to Butterfly and loop wool and knot for antennae.
