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Here is a pattern so that you can create your very own Little Seahorse at home.

Maybe you could create a Seascape of your own!

LITTLE SEAHORSE PATTERN— Pattern created by Katrina Henderson from the **Art Stop Café** (Portsmouth)

This little seahorse is made in 4 pieces, the body is knitted in one piece that folds in half and is sewn together using blanket stitch. The head is also knitted in one piece that folds in half and is sewn up using blanket stitch, this slots on top of the body. The fins are made in two pieces that you sew on. You will need to add stuffing to your body and a little to the head. You can add colour to your seahorse by adding stripes of colour. Please make your seahorse as individual as you like; why not add sequins, fins on his back, beads for the eyes and make as many of these little fellas as you like. Please do not make any of your seahorses larger than 15cm (6 inches). Enjoy!!

Difficulty Rating: Intermediate: Needle size 4/5mm (UK7) Wool: Double Knitting Yarn Approx size 15cm (5-6 inches)

Knitting Key: K- Knit P- Purl Kfb- Knit in to front and back of stitch (increase) K2tog- Knit two stitches together.

Body (make 1)

Cast on 2 stitches

Row 1. Knit (2)

Row 2. Purl (2)

Cast on 10 stitches
